The Scholarship Program

Our scholarship programs are designed to support MBA candidates who demonstrate strong determination, initiative, and the potential to develop into charismatic, responsible leaders. We are particularly interested in applicants whose educational or professional path differs from conventional career trajectories and who bring distinctive perspectives shaped by their background and personal presence. Scholarships may reduce the MBA tuition fee **by up to 40%**, subject to the selection decision and the applicable scholarship conditions.

Eligibility and key requirements

Any self-funded student may apply for a scholarship provided that an application to the Darmstadt Business School MBA program (full-time or part-time) has already been submitted. Scholarship applications must be submitted by **1 June** each year for the upcoming first semester.

A complete scholarship application includes, in addition to the documents you provided with your MBA application, the following:

- The completed scholarship application form
- Letter of motivation (maximum 2 pages)
- Letter of recommendation
- Extended curriculum vitae (if applicable)
- Additional job references (if required)
- Certificates and further education certificates (if applicable)
- Language certificates (if applicable)
- Other relevant certificates (if applicable)

Scholarship obligations and important notes

Scholarship recipients will conclude a scholarship agreement. In principle, scholarships cannot be combined with other reductions or discounts. Scholarship holders are expected to actively support the MBA program and Darmstadt Business School—for example, by acting as an ambassador at information events, participating in interviews, providing a portrait for the program website, and contributing testimonials or engagement through the University's communication channels.
